

The **annual meeting 2022** at the invitation of the *Museum für Vor- und Frühgeschichte* will be held as a **hybrid conference**.

We hereby announce the **call for papers**. Contributions (presentation of max. 20 minutes and/or poster) can but do not have to be related to the meeting's focal topic

"State of the Art -

Advances in the study of Palaeolithic and Mesolithic creative behaviour"

We strongly encourage everyone to join the meeting in presence. As we do not know how the pandemic situation will be next spring, the part in presence will be held under the then valid hygienic rules (at least vaccinated and/or recovered). Due to pandemic restrictions in all possible directions (travel restrictions, potential limit of participants in presence, personal reasons ...) the meeting will also provide a **hybrid solution**. The **hybrid format** offers: giving presentations and following the other talks and discussions.

Since the conference booklets are accessible online, we refrain from automatically sending the printed version by post to those members who will not participate in the meeting, or who participate in the hybrid version. Arrival

Museumsinsel:

Please use the public transport to get to Museumsinsel, as there are almost no possibilities for parking.

Please arrive at the following stations that are in 5-10 min walking distance to the venue:

Subway station *Museumsinsel*Train ("S-Bahn") and subway station *Friedrichstraße*Train ("S-Bahn") station *Hackescher Markt*

Venue in Dahlem:

Please use the public transport to get to Dahlem, as there are almost no possibilities for parking.

Starting from the center of Berlin you have the following options to reach stations that are in 3 min walking distance to the venue:

Subway *U3* to the subway station *Dahlem Dorf*

Or you travel with train ("S-Bahn") or subway to the station *Rathaus Steglitz* and from there you take the *Bus X83* to the station *Edwin-Redslob-Straße*.
